The Six Layers of Construction Security

- 1** → **Perimeter Protection**
- 2** → **Access Control**
- 3** → **Mobile Surveillance**
- 4** → **AI Detection**
- 5** → **Live Monitoring**
- 6** → **Cloud Reporting and Site Intelligence**

Layer 1: Perimeter Protection

Purpose: Establish the first line of defense around the jobsite.

Protects against:

- Trespassing
- Opportunistic theft
- Vehicle intrusion
- Unauthorized site access

Typical Solutions:

- Fencing/Gates
- Mobile surveillance
- Lighting
- Clear site signage

Layer 2: Access Control

Purpose: Control who enters the site and when.

Protects against:

- Unauthorized personnel
- Unapproved vehicles
- Contractor accountability gaps
- Access disputes

Typical Solutions:

- LPR (License Plate Recognition)
- ID badges
- Keycard access
- Entry logging



Layer 3: Mobile Surveillance

Purpose: Provide flexible security coverage that moves as the project evolves.

Protects against:

- Perimeter blind spots
- Equipment theft
- Material theft
- Changing site layouts

Typical Solutions:

- Solar Surveillance Trailers
- Pole Cameras
- Temporary surveillance systems

Layer 4: AI Detection

Purpose: Automatically identify potential threats before they escalate.

Protects against:

- After-hours intrusions
- Fire and smoke
- Unauthorized activity
- High-risk zone breaches

Typical Solutions:

- Intrusion Detection
- AI Video Analytics
- Fire and Smoke Detection
- Intelligent alerting



Layer 5: Live Monitoring

Purpose: Ensure every alert is verified and acted upon.

Protects against:

- False alarms
- Delayed responses
- Escalating incidents

Typical Solutions:

- 24/7 Remote Monitoring
- Live audio intervention
- Police escalation
- Verified alarm response

Layer 6: Cloud Reporting and Site Intelligence

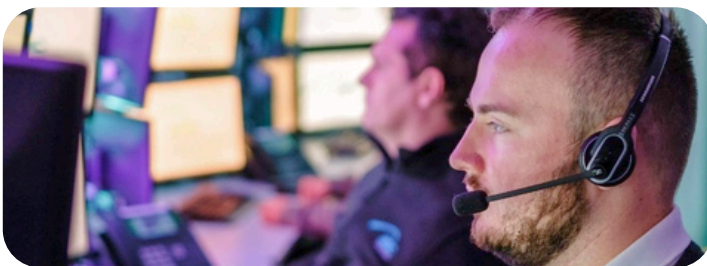
Purpose: Gain complete project visibility and a documented security record.

Protects against:

- Compliance gaps
- Insurance disputes
- Limited operational visibility

Typical Solutions:

- Cloud-based management platform
- Timestamped activity logs
- Incident reporting
- Multi-site dashboards
