Site Setup

Security Preparation

- ☐ Security risks assessed
- ☐ Equipment and material storage areas designated
- ☐ Monitoring and surveillance measures planned
- ☐ Incident response procedures established

Asset Protection

- ☐ High-value equipment inventory completed
- ☐ Fuel and material storage secured
- ☐ Delivery schedules coordinated
- ☐ Contractor access procedures documented

Weather and Environmental Planning

- ☐ Severe weather response plan in place
- ☐ Hurricane season considerations reviewed
- ☐ Drainage and flood risks assessed
- ☐ Emergency contact information distributed
- ☐ Environmental monitoring tools acquired

Workforce and Operations

- ☐ Contractor onboarding completed
- ☐ Site rules communicated
- ☐ Health and safety procedures established, e.g. PPE monitoring
- ☐ Inspection schedules and/or AI-detection technology implemented
